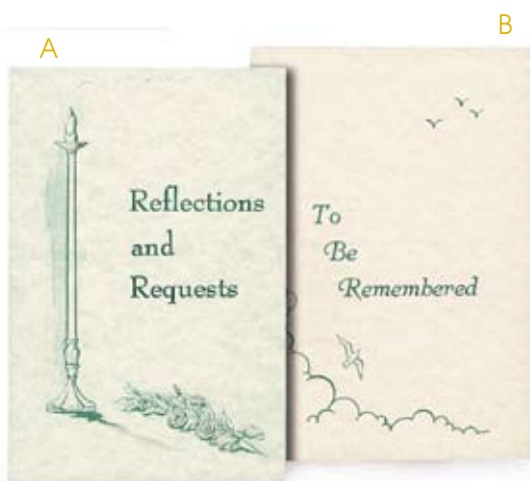


FAMILY RESOURCES

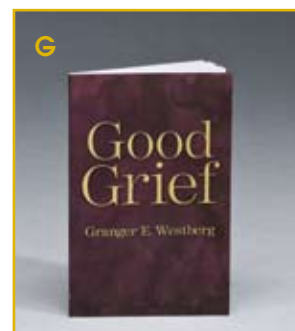

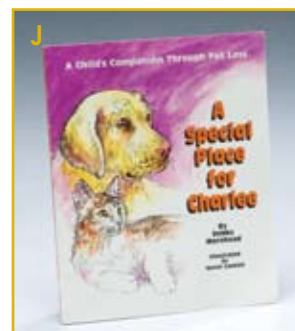
